TASTING NOTES

This silky Pinot Noir showcases sumptuous sweet cherries, cherry pie, and subtle, earthy aromatics of morning dew and pine. Mouthwatering red berry flavors blossom on the palate, while supple acidity and mellow tannins contribute to the wine's innate elegance. A hint of oak lingers on the palate, gliding the wine to a graceful finish.
