TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromas jump out of the glass with this beautiful, dark Cabernet Sauvignon. Notes of cocoa, mocha, and hazelnut intrigue the senses. Flavors of black cherry, cassis, plum, and cola delight the palate leading to supple tannins that carry through a lengthy finish. The Double Lariat Cabernet Sauvignon is highly elegant yet accessible for any occasion and any connoisseur.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

The tannin structure and fruit-forward notes pair beautifully with lamb rib eye, smoked beef tenderloin carpaccio and spinach-stuffed mushrooms.

JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS *is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.*
