"This is an expensive offering blended to be the same stylistically from year to year. The fruit this vintage comes 33% from San Benito County, 33% from Monterey County and 34% from Sonoma County. Pale to medium ruby, the 2017 Reata Pinot Noir Three County opens with cinnamon stick, potpourri, roses, fresh cranberries, citrus peel and warm red berries with nuances of amaro and dusty earth. The palate is light to medium-bodied and rounded with spicy fruits framed by gentle, grainy tannins and juicy freshness, finishing long." - Erin Brooks

Reata comes from the Spanish word for lariat and lasso. The lasso honors our winery's ranching tradition and winemaking philosophy. Just as lassos are woven together, our wines are sourced from exceptional vineyards and woven together by our winemaker. Our Winemaker Linda Trotta joined us in 2017 following three decades of experience. In 2018, Linda was named the North Bay Business Journal's Napa Valley Winemaker of the Year.
