And like the tree represented on our labels, no detail for us is considered too intricate. Our array of unadulterated, exceptional Edna Valley Chardonnays and Pinot Noir are all hand crafted to captivate and exude vivid elegance.

ABOUT Refined, rich, and perfectly balanced, Baileyana wines are as beautiful and intricate as the tree for which they are named. The round, creamy mouthfeel is complemented by aromatic oak and the bright acidity of our cool climate fruit.
