
EDNA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

ABOUT Vibrant single vineyard, cool-climate wines from Edna Valley with intense varietal character and good acid structure to be enjoyed with a wide range of foods.

TASTING NOTES Full of flavors of zesty citrus, guava and passionfruit with a chalky minerality and a hint of salinity. The perfect combination of Sauvignon Blancs from New Zealand and Sancerre, this wine is bursting with fruit flavors and balanced with the perfect amount of racy acidity.

WINEMAKER Rob Takigawa

WINEMAKING Sourced from a SIP Certified Sustainable vineyard in the cool climate of Edna Valley with volcanic soils, this wine is harvested at different levels of ripeness. One portion is picked a bit early; the higher acid and lower sugar in the berries bring a crisp citrus and slight herbal character. The middle portion is harvested at balanced ripeness, while the third is picked a little later in the season. The fruit in this last batch provides tropical notes and a round mouthfeel. Fermented at cold temperatures in stainless steel, there is no oak or influence or malolactic fermentation.



ABOUT Mother Nature is intriguing and elusive, reigning on high with grace and beauty. We show our respect to Mother Nature by creating this quality wine that exhibits the true elegance of Chardonnay from Edna Valley. Each vintage of this wine mirrors the splendor of Mother Nature.

TASTING NOTES Displaying aromas of ripe pear, pineapple, tangerine and caramel, this is a classic Chardonnay from California. It is rich and creamy and bursting with tropical fruit flavors. Refreshing acidity keeps the wine lively on the finish, it is balanced by the excellent accompaniment of vanilla bean and toasted oak. **WINEMAKER** Rob Takigawa

The round, creamy mouthfeel is complemented by aromatic oak and the bright acidity of our cool climate fruit. ABOUT Cooled by the nearby Pacific Ocean, Edna Valley offers the perfect conditions for growing elegant, fine Chardonnay. Named Firepeak after selected blocks in the vineyard, this wine was born in the volcanic soils below the once active nearby peaks. TASTING NOTES A bright but complex Chardonnay, this wine has upfront favors of crisp pear, lemon zest, pineapple, and hints of vanilla. Aromas of citrus and honeydew melon highlight the chalky minerality that runs throughout. This wine is smooth and balanced with refined acid structure, and a nice creamy finish.







VARIETAL BREAKDOWN Albariño

ABOUT Vibrant single vineyard, cool-climate wines from Edna Valley with intense varietal character and good acid structure to be enjoyed with a wide range of foods. Albarino, a prominent white wine in Spain for centuries, has just recently taken a foothold in the U.S. We are excited to be at the forefront of the domestic movement.

TASTING NOTES Made in the traditional style of Rías Baixas Albariño, this wine is pure and vibrant, with a slight salty characteristic. Mandarin orange and tangerine peel begin in the aromatics and run clear through to the finish. The round mouthfeel is beautifully balanced by a somewhat crisp acid structure. The refreshing quality of this wine makes it an excellent aperitif, and it pairs well with most seafoods.

Medium-bodied with crisp acidity and a creamy mouthfeel, it pairs well with a wide range of foods including seafood, pasta with light sauces, even grilled sausage.

TASTING NOTES Round and energetic, with great acid structure, this wine is steely and has pronounced minerality. It has bright aromas of lemon and lime on the nose, a strong white pepper note, and flavors of ripe melon and fruit cocktail.

ABOUT Vibrant single vineyard, cool-climate wines from Edna Valley with intense varietal character and good acid structure to be enjoyed with a wide range of foods.

TASTING NOTES The Pinot Noir brings a salmon color nuance while the hints of Syrah and Grenache add a cherry hue to the Rosé. Albariño delivers rose petal, apple and pear, the Grüner brings citrus and spice while the Viognier contributes floral and subtle notes of tropical fruits.

WINEMAKING Our Rosé represents a modern avant-garde approach to a new progressive category of New World Rosés. We turned the Rosé recipe upside down and utilized our unique and rare cool climate varieties. Fermented in stainless steel at cool temperatures to perserve the aromatic intensity.

TASTING NOTES This Cabernet Sauvignon is pure Paso Robles, full of polished aromas of blueberry, cherry and vanilla, leading to flavors of dark red uits, black currents and hints of pepper. mocha and caramelized oak. Rich yet smooth, this wine is very approachable now, and will continue to mature for years to come.

WINEMAKING The Paso Robles AVA is a large, diverse appellation that begins six miles away from the Pacific Ocean. While the hot days allow Cabernet Sauvignon to fully ripen, the Ocean influence and higher elevations of the hillsides bring cool nighttime temperatures that maintain high acidity in the grapes. AGING* 15-18 months on 40% new French Oak
