This wine is a blend of two celebrated Clones. Clone 667 brings red fruit, elegance and velvety mouthfeel. Clone 777 imparts darker fruit with structure.

VINTAGE Early season frost and an early summer had no ill effects other than lower yield on the vintage. The 2022 vintage will be remembered for low yields with concentrated, small-sized berries.
