Our goal is to make a memorable, accessible Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley, our Bread & Butter home. We carefully source this Cabernet from vineyard sites on the valley floor with deep soils, warm days and cool nights. This brings ripe fruit and a luscious taste experience. Aging on French oak imparts sweet spice notes and elegance.

VINTAGE A warm and predominantly dry 2022 season in Napa Valley, punctuated by a late-summer heat spike, accelerated ripening and produced Cabernet Sauvignon with concentrated fruit, supple tannins, and lifted aromatics. Despite a compressed harvest window, careful canopy and irrigation management preserved balance, yielding expressive wines with richness and approachability.


