Sonoma wine country is brimming with fables (of varying degrees of truth) passed down through the generations, usually aided by a celebrated local wine. Storyteller wines encourage your stories to unfold in ever more fantastic versions.

Appellation

Sonoma County’s diverse geography allows grapes to thrive in a variety of sub-climates. Cooling breezes and morning fog from the Pacific Ocean to the west are ideal for cool climate grapes and the mountainous regions that sit above the fog line are perfect for hot climate grapes that thrive in lots of sun.

Oak Treatment: French oak 35-40%, American oak 5%

Ageing: 12 months

Tasting Notes

This wine begins with delicate aromas of earthy cedar, black cherry, and vanilla spice. Every sip reveals robust flavors of juicy plum, dark chocolate, and deep butterscotch. Tannins grip the tastebuds and make you go back for another glass.

Food Pairing

Cab and beef, a match made in heaven! Pair with grilled burgers on a brioche bun or ribeye steak with chimichurri sauce.
