“Once Upon a Dream” Merlot

Sonoma wine country is brimming with fables (of varying degrees of truth) passed down through the generations, usually aided by a celebrated local wine. Storyteller wines encourage your stories to unfold in ever more fantastic versions.

Appellation

Sonoma County’s diverse geography allows grapes to thrive in a variety of sub-climates. Cooling breezes and morning fog from the Pacific Ocean to the west are ideal for cool climate grapes and the mountainous regions that sit above the fog line are perfect for hot climate grapes that thrive in lots of sun.

Oak Treatment: French oak 30-35%

Aging: 6-8 months

Tasting Notes

Aromas of cherry fruit, red raspberry, milk chocolate and warm spices. A silky mid-palate with mature tannins followed by a long finish.

Food Pairing

This Merlot brings out the best in osso buco or other braised meats. Eggplant parmesan or linguini are excellent vegetarian options.
