Appellation

Sonoma County’s diverse geography allows grapes to thrive in a variety of sub-climates. Cooling breezes and morning fog from the Pacific Ocean to the west are ideal for cool climate grapes and the mountainous regions that sit above the fog line are perfect for hot climate grapes that thrive in lots of sun.

Aging: 4 months in Stainless Steel

Tasting Notes

Aromatic hints of summer grass and flavors of pineapple and tropical fruit fill out the mid-palate and finish fresh.

Food Pairing

This medium bodied Sauvignon Blanc pairs well with mussels, panzanella with asparagus or whole fish roasted with potatoes.
