VINEYARD NOTES

Globberati Cabernet Sauvignon's grapes come from two regions of France. First, the Languedoc region in the south of France, just inland from the Mediterranean Coast, where the fruit provides the body and full, fruity characteristics of the wine. Second, from the cooler and more western region, Gers in Gascony, where the cooler climate provides juicy, aromatic, acidic fruit flavors that combines beautifully with the Languedoc fruit.

WINEMAKING NOTES

This well-balanced red wine's fruit from the Gers region was fermented at relatively cool temperatures in stainless steel tanks. While the Languedoc portion of the wine was fermented on French oak staves, before blending, to create Globberati Cabernet Sauvignon — a delicious, easy-drinking red offering fantastic value.

TASTING NOTES

From the celebrated vineyards of rural France, this pleasantly well-balanced Cabernet Sauvignon has a smooth medium-body that bursts with juicy cassis and blackberry finishing with hints of mocha.

FOOD PAIRING

This bold, Cabernet Sauvignon pairs well with fresh homemade grilled pizza. It's also ideal with roasted vegetables, grilled red meats and hard cheeses.



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
