THE EDNA VALLEY

The coolest growing region in all of California, as cited in a study by Southern Oregon University, the Edna Valley is a mere 5.4 miles from the Pacific Ocean. Consequently, the extended growing season allows grapes grown here to develop intense and complex varietal flavors, while achieving optimum maturity levels. Known as the “Dirt of the Devil,” the soils in the northern portion of the valley are also unique. As Islay Hill is the most southern sibling in a chain of extinct volcanoes known as the Seven Sisters, volcanic remnants are combined with clay loam and rocky marine sediment, offering a distinct mix of nutrients and good drainage.

2025 VINTAGE

The 2025 Edna Valley growing season was defined by a cool spring, mild summer temperatures and an extended, steady ripening period. With no major heat events, morning fog and cool Pacific breezes allowed Pinot Noir to mature gradually while preserving its natural acidity. Late-season rainfall required careful vineyard management and precise harvest timing, but the fruit arrived with excellent flavor development at lower sugar levels. The resulting 2025 Baileyana Pinot Noir displays vibrant aromatics, concentrated color and flavor, and graceful structure—capturing the vintage’s remarkable freshness, balance and finesse.

TASTING NOTES

Exemplifying the vivid excellence of the Edna Valley, this Pinot Noir bursts with expressive dark fruit notes, currants and blueberries, along with a hint of vanilla and cherry cola. The wine has a brilliant acidity that is balanced by notes of ripe cherry and structured by soft, supple tannins that lead to a long, memorable finish.
